



Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Valley Associates Global Security Corporation (Valley) is a representative for many corporations around the world in Canada, as well as an integrator of various technologies and manufactures some products. Valley is committed to being a responsible corporate citizen and is opposed to human rights abuses. As part of that commitment, Valley seeks to source products, components and materials from companies that share our values around human rights, ethics and environmental responsibility. Valley is committed to conducting ourselves in all business activities to the highest standards of ethics and social responsibility and providing our customers with responsibly sourced products.

Furthermore, we will endeavor to use sourcing methods to reduce the risk of sourcing conflict minerals from mines, smelters or refiners, and is in most cases several or more levels removed from these market participants. Valley therefore requires our suppliers to implement controls on their supply chain consistent with Valley's responsible sourcing commitment. Suppliers who supply or manufacture components, parts or products containing conflict minerals are required to source those minerals from ethically and socially responsible sources that do not directly or indirectly contribute to conflict. Without limiting the foregoing, suppliers are expected to directly and indirectly source conflict minerals only from sources that do not directly or indirectly benefit or finance armed groups, within the meaning of the Conflict Minerals Rule, in the DRC or other covered countries. Among other things, we require our suppliers to, where possible, source from smelters and refiners that are validated as being conflict free and otherwise implement, and require their direct and indirect suppliers to implement, policies, due diligence frameworks, risk mitigation strategies and management systems that are consistent with the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD Guidance).

Valley does not knowingly source conflict minerals from sources that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the covered countries. If we determine that a supplier may be violating this policy, we require them to engage in measurable risk mitigation efforts that are consistent with the OECD Guidance. Valley shares concerns for the responsible sourcing of the materials used in products provided to use and continues to make progress to the common goal of ethically sourced minerals and socially responsible supply chains.
